Subject: - Discussion on approval of Online training on Ethical Hacking & Industry demanded

Background: - In compliance to decision taken in 10th Meeting of BoG meeting illustrated at Agenda-06/10 for the procurement of below mentioned services already been done through GeM. Since this matter was finalized at the institution level by forming the committee there was no need to place the matter to purchase and sales committee by the University.

This is also to bring in the notice to the board that tender for the ethical hacking training was initially budgeted for Rs. 45, 00,000 (Forty five Lakh only) for the training of 2000 No. of students but due to the shortage of fund and on the basis of recommendation of Academic coordinator only the work order for the 1000 Nos. inspite of 2000 No. of participants having PO Value of Rs.21,00,200 (Twenty One lakh two hundred only) was issued to the M/s- Shramsamarthan consultancy Pvt. Ltd. ,New Delhi. Since training is already been completed through the online mode and invoices for the same has already been generated by the vendor through the GeM and the reports submitted by the vendor was found satisfactory by the Academic coordinator. Further payment may be released after the seeking approval from the board.

Resolution: - The matter was discussed in detail and it was resolved by the board that since purchase and sales committee as a tender opening committee is already been involved in the technical and financial bid opening of both the tenders and final decision for the same has already been taken by the committee formed by the University. Hence, board approved the tendering procedures adopted by the University through the GeM along with the budget and work order for 1000 participants having PO Value of Rs.21,00,200.00 (Twenty One Lakh two hundred only). Further it was also decided by the board that payment to the concerned vendor must be released before the 31st March, 2021 on the basis of satisfactory report of training. Finally board approved both the trainings (Ethical Hacking & Industry demanded courses) along with the budget and tendering process followed.

<u>Subject:</u> - Discussion on approval of payment for the services procured for conducting training on Industry demanded courses.

Background: - Work order for conducting the Industry demanded courses has been issued to M/s-Softpro India computer Technologies Pvt. Ltd dated 13.02.2021 having PO value of Rs.25,66,201.00 (Twenty Five Lakh Sixty Six Thousand Two Hundred One only). Training for the same is going to be completed on 20th March 2021 probably. As per the terms and condition stipulated in the work order 100% payment to the vendor may be released after the generation of invoices through GeM and submission of reports to the University. In compliance to the post training support required by the Vendor for 1 Month after the completion of training, GeM will allow the generation of invoices in the end of April Month only. By keeping in view of TEQIP-III project closure by 31st March, 2021 University needs to clear the payment before the closure of project on the basis of satisfactory report and seller's Invoice only.

This Matter is being placed before the board for kind consideration and approval.

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Resolution: - The matter was discussed in detail and the letter of request submitted by M/s Softpro India Computer Technologies Pvt. Ltd. regarding releasing the payment on the basis of seller's invoice inspite of GeM invoice was considered by the board and it was further resolved by the board that payment to the concern vendor must be released after the commencement of training by 20th March, 2021 on the basis of satisfactory report to be submitted by the vendor. Board also suggested the University to take the declaration regarding tallied amount with the sellers invoice and GeM invoice. In case any differences found in the GeM invoice and Seller's invoice only the concerned firm will solely be responsible.

Subject: Discussion on payment to "EICT-IIT Kanpur"

Background:- Since no tendering method was followed in selecting EICT-IIT Kanpur for the summer internship training program and work order has been directly issued to EICT by the AKU under TEQIP-III project. After the discussion on same matter in 3rd meeting of State Steering committee held on 8th Jan,2021 Letter to CPA,NPIU has already been sent for the providing the guideline in this matter. Response for the same has been received by NPIU through the E-mail dated 3rd March, 2021 replying that payment to IIT Kanpur may be released after approaching the authorities like BoG /SSC/DST who had already been involved in the approval process. Since total pending amount is of **Rs. 1,74,70,000.00** (One Crore seventy four Lakh Seventy thousand only) as per the two invoices received through IIT-Kanpur.

This matter is being put before the board for discussion and necessary action as needed.

Resolution: - It was observed that IIT-Kanpur is an eminent institute and the summer internship training conducted by the EICT-IIT Kanpur was found satisfactory as per the feedback received from the students thus the payment for the training was approved at the BoG Level. Since no tendering method was followed for selecting the EICT-IIT Kanpur due to COVID-19 pandemic and DST was also involved during the approval process of the activities so final payment to the Vendor may be released after taking the consent from State Steering committee (SSC) and BoG recommended to put the matter in SSC meeting going to be held on 19.03.2021

As per the EP-04/M-32 report these payments are showing under debit pending and not credited to the respective accounts of the vendor. This matter has already been escalated to the NPIU dated 27.02.2021 having letter no. 754. Since this matter is still not resolved by the concerned authorities and keeping in view of project closure by 31st March, 2021. University suggested to repeat the transaction to the vendors after taking the declaration/bond from the vendor declaring that in case if repeated amount get credited to the vendor's account they had to refund the amount within a week to AKU, TEQIP-III in the form of DD.

This matter is being put before the board for kind consideration and approval

Resolution: - As per the telephonic conversation with NPIU, New Delhi it was informed to the University that they should wait for two days for the resolving the debit pending issue from the bank end and same was suggested by the board to the university.

Subject: - Discussion on the final status and closure of the CRS project .

Background: - Advance made to the 57 PI's under the CRS scheme of TEQIP-III of amount Rs.42, 11,250.00 (Forty two Lakh Eleven thousand two hundred fifty only) was not completely adjusted till date. As per the notification released by the University last date for receiving the bills was 31st Jan, 2021. Despite of several remainders to PI's, bills from the 37 PI's out of 57 PI's is still pending for the advance adjustment. Details are mentioned below:-

Total remaining amount of Rs. 27,12,500.00 for the adjustment from 37 PI's needs to be adjusted before the closure of the project i.e., before 31st March, 2021.

Pending amount may be recovered through the PI's as per the CRS norms by surrendering the project to University and amount should be returned to the AKU, TEQIP-III through the DD (Demand Draft).

This matter is being placed before the board for discussion and seeking necessary action.

Resolution: - The matter was discussed and it was further suggested by the board that unspent/unsettled advance must be recovered from the PI's in the form of DD in favour of "AKUTEQIP FUND" payable at CNLU Branch (code- 15996),Patna before the 23.03.2021. And same cumulative amount must be sent to NPIU, New Delhi for the re-appropriation of the fund in respective head. It was further suggested by SPA (I/c), SPIU, Bihar to invite all the PI's in the upcoming audit meeting of CRS going to be held on 23.03.2021(tentative) at University.

Subject: - Discussion on the approval of online training of English communication skills based on blended model.

Background:- As per the proposal received from the Academic coordinator for conducting the training on English communication skills training based on blended model for 60 hrs (Online classroom + web based platform) AKU under TEQIP-III had floated the tender through the GeM having Bid No. GEM/2021/B/1069808, dated 26.02.2021. Details of the package are mentioned below:-

Technical bid for the same was opened on 09.03.2021. After the technical re-evaluation of the bids on 15.03.2021 by the purchase and sales committee three firm were found qualified and the financial bid for the same was proposed to be opened on the same day but the committee had recommended to open the financial bid after taking the final decision by BoG on following points:-

- 1. All the payments are to made latest by 31st March, 2021
- 2. As per the tender training period should be of minimum 10 days.

Bid documents along with the scope of courses and additional terms and conditions, estimated budget & proceedings of tender opening committee is being placed before the board for the discussion and necessary action.

Resolution: - Due to the short span of time left in the project the execution of the online English communication skills training within the 10 days seems not to be possible to conclude before the project closure. So, the board suggested the university to cancel the tender having GeM Bid No. GEM/2021/B/1069808 floated in the GeM. In case of extension of project re-tender for procurement of same services may be done as per the NPIU instruction.

Subject: - Discussion on the approval of procurement of 36 units of Air-conditioners.

Background: - In compliance to decision taken in the 11th BoG cum EC meeting at Agenda 12/11 dated 07-12-2020, tender for the procurement of 36 units of AC with the pre-approved specification was floated through the GeM having Bid No. GEM/2021/B/989244 dated 21.01.2021 but due to the warranty issue for 5 years as per the requirement of bid only three bids were received before the closing date of tender. Hence previous bid was cancelled after obtaining the approval from administrative level. Same tender has been floated after reducing the warranty on machine to only one year having bid no. GEM/2021/B/1028562 dated 09.02.2021. After following the procurement procedures single bidder was found qualified and work order for the same has been issued to the vendor. Background:- In compliance to the decision taken in 11th Meeting of BoG cum EC meeting at agenda 18/11 for the setup of video conferencing at AKU through the TEQIP fund was initialized by the University for which approval regarding the estimated budget and method of procurement was obtained from the Goods and procurement committee and further approval for the technical specification of VC system was obtained from the technical evaluation committee. Finally as per the availability in GeM the tender for the procurement of equipments required for the VC is floated in the GeM having Bid No. GEM/2021/B/1099768 dated 09.03.2021. Technical bid will be opened after 19.03.2021.

Bid documents along with technical specifications, proceedings of the goods and procurement committee meeting and technical specification committee is placed before the board for kind consideration and approval.

Resolution: - The matter was discussed and it was resolved by the board that tender may be kept on hold until the notification of the extension of project to be received from the NPIU. Further work order may be issued to the qualified bidders after the evaluation of bids through the purchase and sales committee subject to availability of funds in respective head. Finally the Board approved the proceedings of Goods & Procurement committee meeting & Technical specification committee along with the bid documents & technical specification uploaded in the GeM.

Approximate budget for the procurement of these items is 4.0 to 4.50 Lakh as per the estimate provided by the vendor after the inspection of site.

Since other accessories were unavailable in the GeM so it may be procured from the direct market after taking the decision at University level. Finally board approved the estimated budget of Rs. 4.5 Lakhs for procuring the above said equipments/accessories as per the required quantities.
